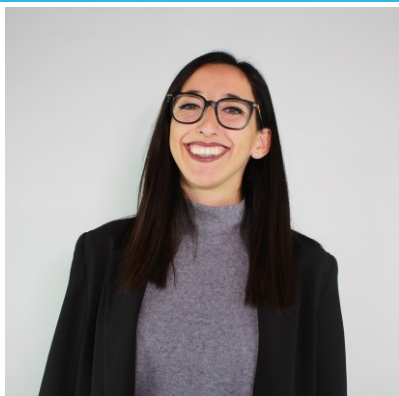
The European Commission is increasingly committed to promoting gender equality in research and innovation. The European regulatory framework is well defined and clear, the required "Gender Equality plan" is just an example. But the *gender dimension* is not about the ratio of women and men in research project, it's about the research content.

Considering sex, gender and intersectional analysis in research contents improves the scientific quality, the societal relevance of the results and enhances the quality of life for women, men, and non-binary people worldwide.

Aim of this training is to understand better how the gender dimension can be declined and included into research and innovation activities, with a look at concrete examples in the life sciences area. Then, through the analysis of the templates for the European projects (Horizon Europe), we will see where and how to insert the "gender theme" into different proposals.
