20 scholarships designated by the Chamber of Commerce for the Master's Degree in the Adriatic Ionian Macroregion

Teramo, January 30, 2015 --The Chamber of Commerce of Teramo and Frosinone has designated 20 scholarships that will cover the entire cost of the Master's Degree registration fee held at the University of Teramo in "Diritto e impresa nella macroregione Adriatica-ionica"

On January 22 and 23 it was held in Ancona, as Gianluca Sadun Bordoni, Master's Degree coordinator explained, the first Governing Board of the EU strategy for the Adriatic Ionian Macroregion (EUSAIR).

Such strategy, officially adopted by EU in the European Council on 24 October, proposes to increase the cooperation with the four EU member states (Italy, Slovenia, Croatia and Greece) and non EU countries

(Albania, Serbia, Bosnia-Herzegovina and Montenegro).

'The main identified areas, continued Sadun Bordoni, concern the 'Blue Economy', Energy and Transport networks, environmental quality and sustainable tourism'.

Therefore, the Master's Degree in "Diritto e impresa nella Macroregione Adriatic-Ionica" at the University of Teramo, concluded Sadun Bordoni, offers an innovative training programme to enable Italian students as well as students who belong to the other countries of the area, to take full advantage of this opportunity given by this new European integration in the Adriatic area, our area.

The Master's Degree integrated with internships held in businesses and institutions, will allow students to deepen their understanding on the main economic, judicial and political themes of the Adriatic Ionian integration opening itself to new scenarios and new perspectives including employment that this process certainly intends to open.
